

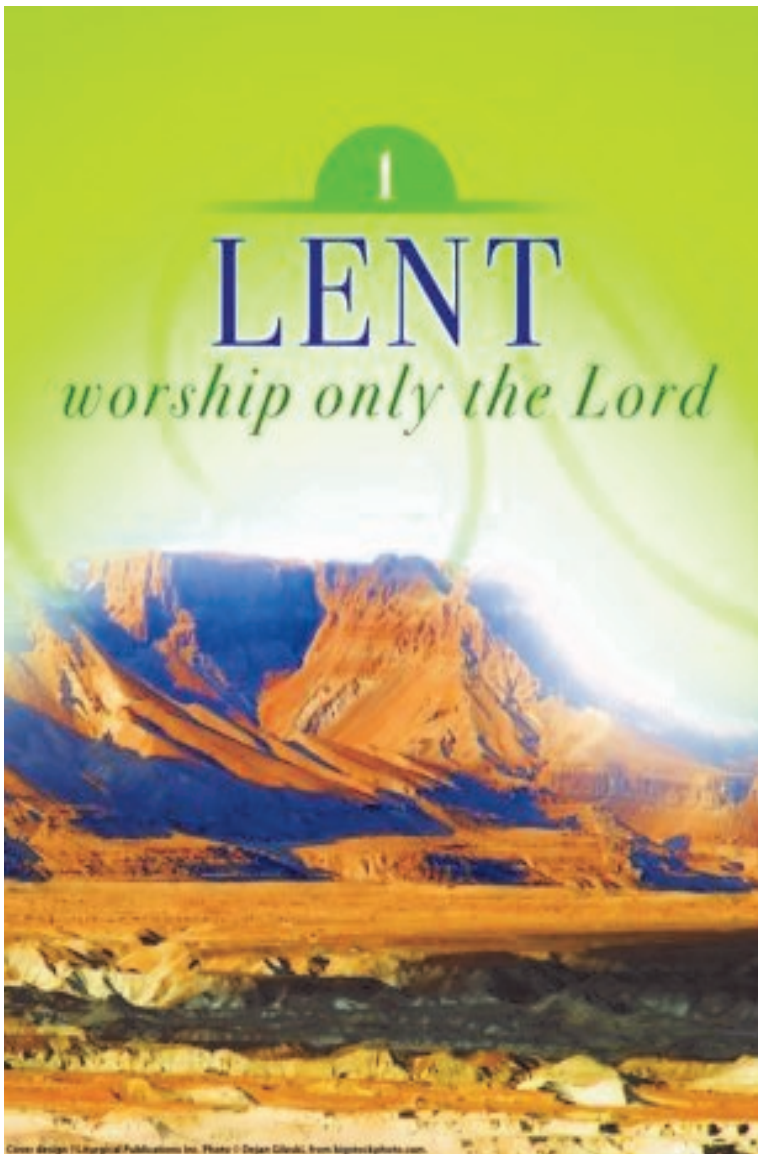

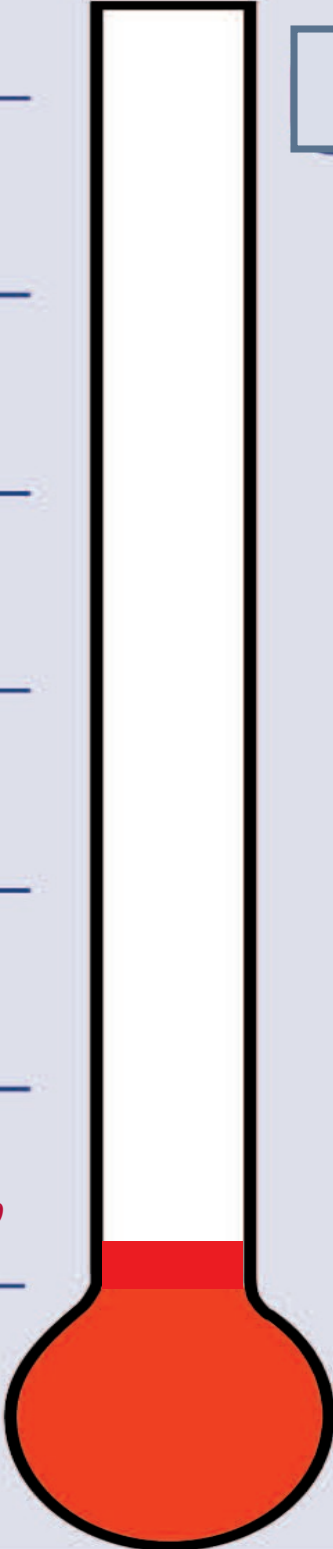

Anointing of the Sick

The anointing of the sick is administered to bring spiritual and even physical strength during an illness or especially near the time of death. A parishioner who is in need of the Sacraments of healing, if possible should call personally or have an immediate family member call the parish office to schedule a priest to visit. The sacrament conveys several graces and imparts gifts of strengthening by the Holy Spirit against anxiety, discouragement, temptation and conveys peace and fortitude. As soon as one feels the effects of age, illness or the nearness of death, the time for the sacrament has already arrived.

Prayer Intentions and Requests

If you would like to be remembered in prayer, please call the parish office with the name of family members who are ill and whom you wish to be remembered in prayer.

In order to respect rights to privacy, these names must be given **by a family member**. It is the responsibility of the person requesting a name on the list to update the parish office list, every two weeks. If we do not hear from you, the assumption is that person has recovered sufficiently to be taken off the Prayer List. Continuing prayer for those we love is very important for all involved, therefore we ask that you call the Parish Office (480) 488-2229, Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm so we may provide a current prayer list.

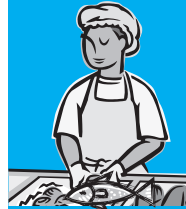

Easter Project Supports 1st way Pregnancy Center

Our Lady of Joy has selected 1st Way of Maricopa County Pregnancy Resource Center as the recipient of the OLJ Easter Project this year.

According to a recent article in the Catholic Sun 1st Way Pregnancy Center, located in central Phoenix, has 4,000 women pass through its doors every year, many in various stages of despair or confusion. They think they may be pregnant and are looking for someone to help them.

It's 1st Way's unofficial motto to be there for the woman. To that end they provide everything for her and the unborn baby free of charge, beginning with an ultrasound so the woman can actually see her baby.

From Jan.-August, 2009, 1st Way provided diapers, clothes, and formula for 1406 babies and provided 494 layettes for newborn babies. Basic items for the newborn babies and their mothers are always in short supply. Each month 160 women complete required classes in life skills at 1st Way which then allows them to receive clothes and diapers for their babies/children. The clothes and diapers are donated through the generosity of people like the parishioners at OLJ.

We are asking for summer maternity wear, summer clothes for newborn babies as well as clothes for the young children that the woman may already have at home. The woman may be concerned that her other children will be neglected because of the new baby's needs.

1st way has very limited storage space and would prefer to have donations made to a diaper fund rather than trying to store the bulky diapers. This diaper fund would enable diaper purchases to be made as needed.

On the weekends of **March 6-7th** and **March 13-14th** bags and tags asking for various items will be displayed in the courtyard at all the masses. Parishioners will return their gift purchases to the courtyard on the weekend of **March 20-21st**

We need courtyard volunteers before and after all of the Masses on all three weekends. OLJ parishioner generosity and participation can make a real difference.

DID YOU KNOW?

Certain devotional prayers have attached to them a partial or a plenary indulgence. A partial indulgence means that a portion of the temporal punishment due to forgiven sin is removed. A plenary indulgence means that by the merits of Jesus Christ, the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the saints, the full remission of the temporal punishment due to sacramentally forgiven sins is obtained.

Indulgences are applied to the prayers of the Litany of the Blessed Mother, the Litany for Priests and the Litany of the Sacred Heart. Join us every Wednesday after the 8:00 am Mass to recite the Litany of the Blessed Mother, on the first Thursday of the month to recite the Litany for Priests, and on the first Friday of each month to recite the Litany of the Sacred Heart.

Receiving an indulgence requires the usual conditions of Sacramental Confession and reception of Holy Eucharist within a week or two of the devotion..

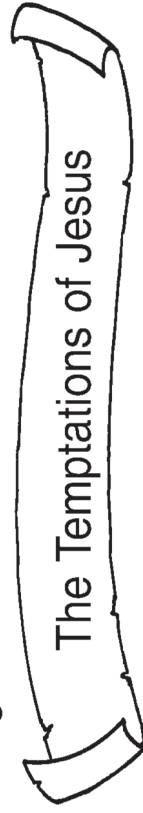

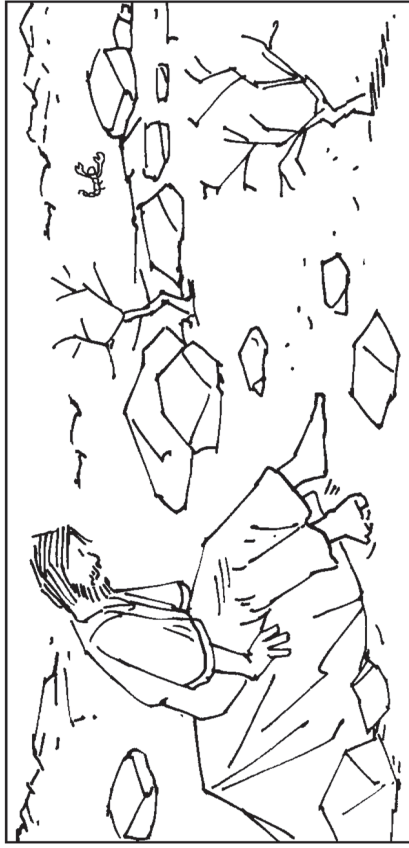
