



June 7, 2020 The Most Holy Trinity

Dear Family of God,

What is Holy Trinity? Or more precisely, who is the Holy Trinity?

The Catechism teaches that **“by sending his Son and the Holy Spirit of love in the fullness of time, God has revealed his innermost secret: God himself is an eternal exchange of love, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and He has destined us to share in that exchange”** (CCC 221).

Jesus is the revelation of the Father; He became Man to show us the Father. He became human like us, so He can show us the Love of the Father. He came so that we can share in the eternal exchange of love of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit. Christ saves us from sin and selfishness so that we can share in the total self-giving love of the Holy Trinity through our union with Him, and through the Holy Spirit.

We just celebrated the Pentecost last weekend; because it is only through Him that we will begin to understand who God is. It is through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us, **“the love of God has been poured out into our hearts.”**

(Romans 5:5)

Love is the essence of the Holy Trinity. When we love, we know God, and if we are without love, we are without God (Cf. 1John 4:7-8). Love moves us to choose what is good for another person. In a sense, love makes us forget ourselves by allowing us to pour ourselves out for the sake of the ones we love.

Whenever we choose to love and act in love, we get a true glimpse of the very life of God. He is pouring Himself out, making a selfless gift of Himself to us not just occasionally but continually, eternally. The only proper response to love is to love in return.

May the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, help us to love God with our whole being and our neighbors as He has loved us.

I rarely do this, but because of two particular emails I received in response to last week's email blast about fear—and due to current events—I'd like to add a bit to those thoughts. (Don't stop halfway through.)

In *Batman Begins*, a character named Scarecrow releases a fear toxic across Gotham City. It feels like the devil has done the same thing to our land.

As I write this, we are dealing with a declared pandemic, people have died, many more have become unemployed, a fire has broken out just miles from the church and has destroyed several homes, those sworn to protect and serve are murdering people on camera, riots are spreading across the land, a curfew has been imposed on law-abiding citizens...and who could forget the murder hornets.

David. You are saying “do not fear.” Are you insane? No. And I'm NOT advocating reckless behavior. Take precautions if you are high risk. Take them out of love for neighbor and your valuable identity as a son or daughter of God. If you feel isolated and just want to talk—call me at 480-346-3042. But don't be fearful. Caution and fear don't have to go hand-in-hand.

Scripture is clear on this point. “Don't put the Lord, your God, to the test.” Take reasonable caution and value your life. Yet, one of the qualities that has set us apart since Peter gave his first public sermon right after Pentecost has been an absence of fear (with the only exception being the fear of separation from God).

Don't believe me? Read Deuteronomy 31:6, Psalm 23:4, 27:1, 34:4–5, 46:1–3, 56:3–4, Matthew 8:25–27, Luke 14:27, 2 Timothy 1:7, and 1 John 4:18–19.

No one who is staying home because they are at elevated risk should feel guilty in the slightest. Nor should they be fearful.

YOUR WELL-BEING AT MASS IS OUR CONCERN

- **Social distancing is required at all Masses.** Please observe the tape lines on the floor for Communion. Every other pew has been taped off in order to maintain distancing. Couples and families may sit together.

What it Takes to Be a Peacemaker

The Beatitudes show us the way of holiness, something that takes us beyond a minimal keeping of Commandments in serious matters.

One of them reads, *"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God."* Mt 5:9

What exactly is this peace we are supposed to make? God defines peace very differently from the absence of trouble:

"I have told you this so that you might have peace in me. In the world you will have trouble, but take courage, I have conquered the world." Jn 16:33

The path of holiness is not for those who want to live a comfortable life, free from trouble. Jesus told us we *would have* trouble; but that we can be courageous because Jesus has "overcome" the world.

This is why someone who tries to avoid conflict at all cost cannot be a peacemaker. Healthy conflict is one way we address injustice. As the saying goes, "There is no peace without justice". But of course the *way we go about* engaging in necessary conflict reveals our heart and whether or not we have the love of God and humanity dwelling therein.

The person who always has an opinion and is always right will not be good at bringing peace. Neither will the person who doesn't care to listen and find out where the other is coming from. Equally bad at peace-making is the person who likes to stoke the fires to divide further by taking sides in arguments that serve little purpose. Lastly, the impulsive social media poster who loves to insult behind the anonymity of the online screen is another fail at peacemaking.

In a time of great division in our world, country, and church, there is urgent need of peacemakers, after the spirit of the Beatitudes. Let's make sure we join the spiritual battle...the only one worth fighting.




