Dear Family of God,



Jesus explains the Parable of the Seed and the Soil: **“The seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundredfold...”** (Matthew 13:23). To listen to the word of God is not enough, we have to understand it too, that is put it into practice in our lives so it will bear fruit. Saint James said in his letter: **“But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves”** (James 1:22).

I remembered an anecdote regarding the parable of the coconut; a mature coconut must be eaten, or, it has to be planted for new life. If we just keep it, it will rot and be wasted. The same is true for the Word of God; just hearing the Word and doing nothing is not enough, **it has to have a transforming effect on our lives**, bearing fruit and helping others to be “fed”, or influenced by it.

God said through the Prophet Isaiah: **“My word shall not return to me void, but shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it.”** (Isaiah 55:11). God has a purpose for why He created us and put us in this time and place. We are to help others know Him, worship Him and serve Him, so we will all be at peace now, and forever happy in heaven. Saint Paul encourages us saying: **“I consider that the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us”** (Romans 8:18).

May Our Lady of Joy, model of obedience, help us to be like her always obedient to the will of God saying to Archangel Gabriel: **“Let it be done to me according to your Word.”**

Pop Quiz! Why did Jesus speak in parables?

When I was younger, I always thought the entire point of the parables was to take complicated teachings and make them understandable through the use of stories.

If that was your answer, you get partial credit. Let’s take another look at the heart of this Sunday’s gospel.

“The disciples approached him and said, “Why do you speak to them in parables?” He said to them in reply, “Because knowledge of the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven has been granted to you, but to them it has not been granted.”

Jesus used parables to as a way to make difficult teachings more understandable to those open to him, while—at the same time—confounding those whose hearts were (and are) closed to him.

How do we know this?

Jesus goes on, “To anyone who has, more will be given and he will grow rich; from anyone who has not, even what he has will be taken away.”

Furthermore, he ends with the parable of the sower.

“The seed sown on the path is the one who hears the word of the kingdom without understanding it, and the evil one comes and steals away what was sown in his heart. The seed sown on rocky ground is the one who hears the word and receives it at once with joy. But he has no root and lasts only for a time. When some tribulation or persecution comes because of the word, he immediately falls away. The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word, but then worldly anxiety and the lure of riches choke the word and it bears no fruit. But the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold.”

May we all be open to the Lord and what he might be telling us.

Serving the Dignity of our Children: Observation as a Tool for Parenting

Help me, O God, to enter into the secret of _____'s (insert child's name) childhood, so that I may know, love and serve _____ (insert child's name) in accordance with your laws of justice and following your holy will.

Skills Needed for Observation On the surface observation sounds simple; watch what the child is doing. However, ...observation requires a certain discipline as adults. ... **Humility** is required, as the observer needs to be empty of preconceptions and agendas. **Patience** is essential as children work in a much slower pace than adults. Often when an adult...notices a child struggling with something, the adult is very tempted to abandon the observation and jump in to assist the child. In ignoring the urge to assist the child, it is often found that the child eventually succeeds without adult assistance. In observing children, it is helpful to watch for the things that catch their attention and engage them. Often those are the things that are emerging in the child to help him develop a new skill. **If we consider the role of parenting as serving children in a manner that allows them to grow and develop to their full potential, then observation is a practice that will assist parents in that work.** [How to Observe Your Child](#) Take some time and just watch your children for at least 20 minutes or so and write down what you see. ... At the end of the day spend some time recalling and writing down the things that caught your child's attention or engaged your child that day. Try to be objective. ... One mother's notes from observing her 3 yr. old: "Today J.J. was noticing temperature differences on the grab bar in the public restroom. The part that was over the heater he labeled as 'hot' and the other section as 'cold.' He took a large scooter venture at the park. He often tries to count things. Today he tried counting the rivets on the bus seat." **By taking time to observe their children parents can identify emerging interests and skills, and then make choices to shape their time and environment that allows their children to continue to grow in that interest or skill.** In the sample above the mother noticing her child's interest in hot and cold, might look for more opportunities to allow him to continue to explore temperature. Perhaps in the bath, or maybe inviting him to feel the pavement in sunny and shady spots on a walk. **The practice of observation can help parents serve their child's development.** [Prayer for the Child](#) **In a sense observation is a spiritual practice because you are placing yourself before the mystery of the child who God chose to be a part of your family. In your practice of observation see what is revealed to you about the mystery of the child or children in your family.**

LIVING AS A MISSIONARY DISCIPLE

God Longs for You

It's difficult for us to realize how much God loves us. Most of our experience is with imperfect human love which can often enough disappoint. It's hard to imagine that we are really and truly loved, individually, completely, totally and infinitely, by the God of the Universe, Whom we cannot see.

St. Paul in his letter to the Ephesians prays that we *"may have the power to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge..."* Eph 3:18-19

The love of God is so deep, vast, and amazing that is "surpasses knowledge". So how can we really know it? It's something that cannot be intellectualized or known in the way that we know other finite, earthly things. The love of God for us transcends all these limited, finite things. But He *does* want us to know His love. We can only know it (and grow in that knowing) as the Holy Spirit reveals it to us. We must allow the Trinity dwelling within us to reveal this love to us. A simple prayer, "Lord, let me know and experience your love for me" will help.

"God loves each of us as if there were only one of us", says St. Augustine. He waits for us and longs for us to turn to Him in prayer. He is sad if we do not come. He, although God, allows Himself to need our response of love to His love. There is nothing we can do that can change the love He has for us. He is "for us" not against us, even when we are against Him.

The joyful living of our Catholic Faith and our ability to spread it to others is directly dependent on our willingness to open our innermost self to God and allow Him to reveal His personal love for us. That Christ *"loved me and gave Himself up for me"* (Gal 2:20) must be the joyful cry in the heart of every Christian. It must be something we *know* deeply. Only then will it spill over into the desire that others may know so great a love. Only then will we really get that the Gospel is indeed "good news" worth sharing.




