

(Being) Catholic Matters

We live in a hurting world.

It is populated with the sick who are contending with chronic pain or illness. It is full of young people who resemble the walking dead as they crank their necks to stare at their phones and block the voices of family with earbuds so they can listen to the voices of strangers. It is inhabited by modern lepers who feel alone and isolated, believing the lie that no one cares about them. And there are those who fight demons of addiction and mental illness.

I don't know what to do about the sick. I want to yell at the teens to look up from their phones and take those things out of their ears. I wish people didn't feel so alone. And I feel bad for those caught in the web of addiction or carrying the burden of mental illness.

But what can I do about any of it?

Most of us just complain, feel bad, or just wish the world was different.

In Matthew 9, Jesus sends out his disciples. He instructs them, "Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons."

When I was homebound after my first surgery, a few parishioners inquired about visiting my home. Since I live 33 miles away, I was so moved by their visits. Others brought meals or purchased meal delivery gift certificates. These acts helped my healing process. Who else do we know who needs a visit? Who needs a meal? Who needs a friend?

We cannot be frustrated with teens burying themselves in their technology, if we aren't willing to set down our phones, close our laptops, or turn off our televisions. We need to offer them relationships worth setting their entertainment aside.

We need to be courageous and greet the stranger at the store. We should call the relative who lives alone. We engage the coworker who seems a bit down.

And we should pray for and financially support organizations that aid those working to overcome addiction or mental illness.

Jesus never told his disciples, "Go out... and complain."

Welcome to Our Lady's Corner-Your Source for Catholic Inspiration!

On this Father's day, let us consider St. Joseph, the great protector and guardian of Jesus. His many titles include: the worker, husband of Mary, foster father of Jesus, patron of the dying,



patron of fathers, terror of demons, protector of the virgin, most pure and most obedient. It is said that anyone who encounters St. Joseph in heaven will bow their head in respect; his dignity is eternal. He seems to be a very often overlooked saint, which is a mistake. Although Mary is our most powerful intercessor, St. Joseph's intercession is quite powerful, too. Did you know that many mystics have had visions of him? Or that he appeared at Fatima at the Miracle of the Sun and blessed the world while holding the child Jesus in his arms?

Consecrating oneself to St. Joseph brings great protection. "St. Joseph the Protector: a Nine-Day Preparation for the Entrustment to St. Joseph" by Dr. Mark Goring, available on Amazon, is a short reading about the most highly honored saint in the Catholic Church, and is a recommended quick read. Consecration to St. Joseph will not obscure Mary, but will enhance consecration to Her.

St. Joseph appeared to St. Faustina and told her to say this prayer daily to gain his support and protection:

Remember, most chased spouse of the Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who implored your help and sought your intercession was left unassisted. Full of confidence in your power, I fly unto you and beg your protection. Despise not, oh guardian of the Redeemer, my humble supplication, but in your bounty, hear and answer me. Amen. Say 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and 1 Glory Be.

Add this prayer to your daily prayer list. Entrust yourself to St. Joseph.


