A MESSAGE FROM FR. JOHN MUIR

A priest friend of mine received a call from a family whose elderly mother was dying. Within thirty minutes, he was at her bedside, offering the consolation of the sacraments, anointing her with the oil of the sick, and commending her soul to God. She passed not long after, and for months, her family spoke of their deep gratitude for his presence. When I phoned him to commend his faithful ministry, he simply said, "I was just doing my job."

His words brought to mind Jesus' teaching this week in Luke 17:10: "So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty." In a world that often seeks recognition and applause, the Lord invites us into a different mindset — one of humble service. The priest did not see his response as extraordinary; he saw it as a grace to fulfill his vocation.

How tempting it is to seek affirmation for doing what I ought to do! Yet Jesus reminds us that true discipleship is not about grandstanding but about quiet faithfulness. It is enough to have served. It is enough to have loved. It is enough to be grateful that we were given the chance to do our duty in the first place. Whether in priesthood, parenthood, or any vocation, what peace-soaked freedom there is in simply doing what is asked of us. No more, no less. Jesus, that is how you quietly love us.

Welcome to Our Lady's Corner— Your Source for Catholic Inspiration



Our blessed Mother is known under many titles, one of which is Mary Undoer of Knots, as we have discussed. How can a sinless woman possibly understand our pain?

Another title she carried is Our Lady of Sorrows. She has seven sorrowful moments that are brought to mind with this title:

- 1) The prophecy of Simeon at the presentation. The Jewish custom was to present every newborn to the temple, and when Joseph and Mary presented Jesus, Simeon shocked her by telling her that a sword would pierce her heart, a prophecy of sorrows to come.
- 2) The flight to Egypt: King Herod heard of the "birth of a king" and ordered all children under the age of 2 to be murdered. An angel came to St. Joseph in a dream and told him to take Mary and Jesus and flee at once. They had to leave with little time to prepare and go live in a different country where they knew neither the culture nor any other person. There they stayed for many years until the end of Herod's reign.
- 3) The loss of the child Jesus. Searching frantically for days, Joseph and Mary finally found Him in the temple.
- 4) Meeting Jesus carrying the cross. She witnessed His gruesome suffering as Jesus struggled to carry the cross through the mad crowd of Jerusalem
- 5) The crucifixion. Mary witnessed the horror of her son hanging for hours on the cross.
- 6) Jesus taken down from the cross. Mary received the beaten and nearly unrecognizable lifeless body of her son as He was taken down from the cross.
- 7) The burial of Jesus. Her grief and shock of the events of the past 24 hours came to fruition as His body was prepared for burial and laid in the tomb.

Reflect on exactly what she saw in each of these moments; how she felt, what she saw. Please believe it - she gets you. She understands your pain deeply, and she can help you untie your knots. She is your mother. What more do you need?


