A MESSAGE FROM FR. JOHN MUIR

Dorothy Day, the great Catholic activist, doubted God's existence. At least in her early adult years. But something changed when after giving birth to her daughter, she experienced an overwhelming gratitude. She later described how, as she held her daughter, the only appropriate response was a kind of unlimited gratitude. She had done nothing to deserve such a gift — this tiny, miraculous life — but there she was, flooded with gratitude, completely undone by the love of such a Giver.

Something similar occurs in Luke 17:19 when Jesus tells a healed leper, **"Stand up and go; your faith has saved you."** This man had already received physical healing through his faith. But the moment of an even deeper transformation came when he turned back, fell at Jesus' feet, and gave thanks. Like Dorothy, this man's gratitude led him to encounter the Giver.

Isn't that what we want, too? Gratitude to God has the power to break our chains of sadness, bitterness, and disenchantment. It empowers us to step out of the prison of self-pity and into the reality of God's abundant love. It shifts our focus from what we lack to what we have received, from what wounds us to what heals us.

Where do we learn this? The Mass. The priest prays: "It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks." Always. Everywhere. Not just when life is easy. Not just when prayers are answered as we expect. Gratitude is not a passive feeling; it is an act of faith. In the eucharist, we remember that Christ himself has given everything for us. And in this act of gratitude, we are healed.

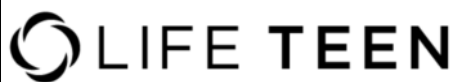

What does this mean? First, let's talk about comfort. Fr. Mike Schmitz, a popular priest on social media, has said that our god has become comfort. Do you perceive this? Do we put our own comfort first? Do we only talk to like-minded people?

Are we uncomfortable telling the truth?

Charlie Kirk was a great example of engaging in discussion about things that make us uncomfortable, and he went to those most swayed by "woke". He did so brilliantly. He always asked what the "opposer" believed and why they believed it. He started by finding out where that person was on their own journey. He then explained why he felt the way he felt, and why he believed what he believed. He frequently came to common ground with the unfortunate person affected by woke ideology. Many woke college students began to change their minds about gender ideology and abortion. He even encouraged students who confided that they were scared and lonely and very specifically led them to Jesus by talking about Jesus - quite often as a matter of fact.

So where do we take it from there? Is there someone in your family or circle of friends who is living a homosexual lifestyle? Engaged in transgenderism? Stating abortion is ok before 15 weeks, or "I wouldn't do it, but I won't tell someone else what to do" (which is actually sanctioning it). YOU are called to tell them the truth!! Come out of your comfort zone and do what Charlie did. Find out where they are in their journey and why they feel what they feel. Then tell why you believe what you believe. Christianity is not a self-help program so you can feel good. You are called to share and evangelize. And Charlie gave us instructions and examples of how to do it. Let's tell the truth with intelligent and respectful conversation. Watch some of his videos on the internet and learn. Do it now. This is a call to action!

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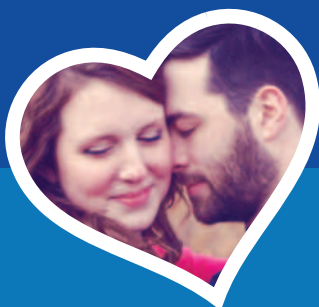
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
