A MESSAGE FROM FR. JESS

Dear Family of God

What is temptation and the three stages of committing sin?

There are three stages of committing sin: First, we perceive it as "good" just like Eve "saw the tree was good for food." We think it is good and can make us happy. But God is the "only Good", the source of our true happiness. Secondly, "It is pleasing to the eyes", if I possess this, I will be happy. And third, "Desirable for gaining wisdom", If I possess this or that, I will be powerful; I will be famous and happy. I will be like God by disobeying God. I will be like God by deciding what is good or evil.

Jesus in our Gospel has showed us how to be victorious over temptations and sin. Tempted with food, He countered it with the word of God: "One does not live by bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God." Tempted to doubt God's love He said: "You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test." And tempted to worship other gods or idolatry; Jesus countered the devil with: "The Lord, your God, shall you worship and Him alone shall you serve."

These three temptations are countered head on by the three practices or discipline of Lent. Temptation for food or for worldly pleasures, we have fasting or self-denial. For doubting God as the source of our joy, we have prayer, increasing our union and conversation with Him will result in cementing our trust in Him. Fruit of prayer is faith. For the temptation to be powerful and famous we have almsgiving or serving our neighbors; being merciful with them as God is merciful with us. Joy is fruit of service. "If you want to be great, be a servant of all" and you will be joyful also.

May we all be victorious against temptation like the Lord.

We often hear that the Catholic Church has so many "rules." Some say that they prefer a protestant church with few "rules." Interesting. The "rules" are actually stringent adherence to what Jesus said. Quite stringent, in fact, and appropriately so. How can we water down what Jesus said? How will that help anyone get to heaven? Jesus is Master and Lord, and only one faith practice can be traced back to Him, and that is the Catholic Church. Every other faith practice can only be traced back to someone who decided to start a church, even though Jesus already did. If one is looking for a watered-down version, they are likely not too interested in an eternity with Him in heaven. Again, interesting.

Further, these "rules" are teachings that come directly from the instruction of the only one who knows how you can reach heaven, and that is Jesus. Could it be that the reason that this feels challenging is because it is in direct opposition to the ideals of this world? The purer the teaching, the better for your salvation, and the more conflicting to this world the teaching will be. In contrast, the more watered-down Jesus' teachings become, the less they are aligned with eternal life. And this is what we would expect from a faith practice stated by someone other than Jesus.

Embrace the Catholic faith in its fullness if you want to come closer to Christ and achieve salvation. A watered-down version is a slippery slope indeed. Jesus is the way, the truth and the light. He said so Himself. In the end, we will be given what we choose on earth. If you do not choose Jesus completely here, He will give you the result of this choice. That sounds like a horrible eternity, right? This is the most important choice you will ever make. What will you choose - Jesus' teaching in its complete fullness and eternal life? Hopefully so.




