A MESSAGE FROM FR. JESS

Dear Family of God,

Why should we wait for the Final Blessings?

The Mass is not over after a Catholic receives Holy Communion. There are actually two critical points in the Mass when the priest speaks and acts "in the Person of Christ." The first is when he consecrates the Bread and Wine, and the second is when he gives the final blessing. This blessing goes back thousands of years to the blessing the priest gave the people at the end of the Temple ceremonies. No one wanted to miss this important blessing from God through the priest, so everyone present would wait in eager anticipation for this final blessing.

Anyone who leaves right after receiving Communion misses the powerful spiritual protection and inspiration this blessing provides. They also break the wonderful spirit of the communion of saints, both those physically present and those in heaven who are worshiping God with us and singing His praises with us in the final hymn.

As we receive Jesus who is the Resurrection and the Life at Holy Communion, and as we receive His final blessing at the end of the Mass, may He strengthen and nourish our spirit through the Holy Spirit who lives within us, so that we all may live in the newness of the life He has given us.

May our Lady of Joy and St. Joseph help us to love and obey Jesus in all that we do. Amen.

Welcome to Our Lady's Corner— Your Source for Catholic Inspiration



We all want to improve our prayer life, but if we are being honest, most don't know how. Let's go back to the beginning. You were created by God to have a relationship with God, and to love, and be loved by God. So, what does that look like for us? The recent Lenten Retreat at our Lady of Joy featured Andre Regnier teaching us how to pray. It is so valuable that it must be shared.

1. Close your eyes and picture the trinity. Now spend about 2 minutes welcoming them - the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, one at a time. When you see a friend at a party, you cross the room to go say hello. This is what you are doing now with the trinity. Saying hello and welcoming them!

2. Spend 2-3 minutes telling them what is going on in your life right now. You should be very honest. They want to know everything - yes, everything. You are not too much for them, so be real. It will likely be easier if you write it down. Writing will help eliminate distractions and help you focus. If you get stuck, say out loud "What I want to say is not too much for them, and they want to hear me say it."

3. Now, close your eyes. Spend some time in worship! Take 2-5 minutes. You can pull out your bible or Google the psalms if you need help. Or, you can just simply praise them your way! Using your own words is just fine.

4. Now, spend 6-7 minutes in "Lectio Divina" which means to read scripture slowly, picture yourself in the scene, and really think about it. Use your imagination as you read. Look up the day's gospel to make it easier to choose a passage. In step 2, you were speaking to God. Now God is speaking to YOU. That is why the bible is called the Living Word. One hundred people can read the same passage and each take away something different because He is speaking to each of His children in a unique way about specific things. This will intensify and deepen your relationship with Him.

5. Resolution - spend 1-2 minutes contemplating your takeaway from this prayer time.

Commit to doing this daily for the next 7 days. Commit to a daily time and the same quiet prayer place. Like anything else, it takes time and practice so be patient and gentle with yourself. You will be so glad that you did.


