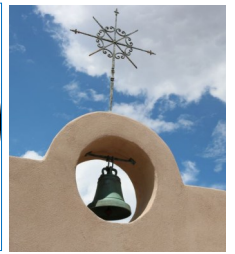
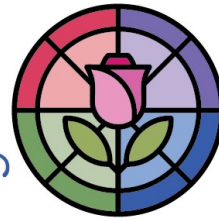

WHAT'S ON FORMED NOW?

Born in 1894 in Poland, Raymond Kolbe grew up in a poor devout household where his parents worked as weavers. At the age of just twelve years old, he had visions of Mary who offered him two crowns - a white one for purity and a red one for martyrdom - and when asked to choose, he responded, "I choose both!"

Pope John Paul II canonized Maximilian Kolbe on October 10, 1982 as a Martyr of Charity and "patron saint of our difficult century." His Feast Day is August 14, and he is the patron saint of journalists, families, prisoners, and the pro-life movement.

The Assumption of Mary

Saturday, August 15th is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a major Catholic Holy Day of Obligation celebrating the belief that, at the end of her life, God lifted Mary up into Heaven, both body and soul. In the United States, the obligation to attend Mass is lifted if August 15th falls on a Saturday or a Monday. Our Lady of Joy will celebrate Mass on Saturday, August 15th and Sunday, August 16th according to the usual schedule.



A MESSAGE FROM FR. JESS

Dear Family of God,

What is courage? How do we acquire this virtue?

Courage or Fortitude is one of the Cardinal Virtues, CCC 1808 defines it as "the Moral Virtue that ensures firmness in difficulties and constancy in the pursuit of the good." We all need courage in order to live uprightly and with dignity especially as followers of Jesus. Only in faith with Jesus Christ that we can live our faith with courage and perseverance, not with fear and retreat.

The main message of our readings this weekend is the words of Jesus to the disciples and to us, "Take courage, it is I, do not be afraid." Jesus is with us, he will not abandon us, and he is always with us especially when we are suffering. The basis of our courage, whether against our natural fear or in support of our firm pursuit of good, is the person of Jesus Christ. His statement, "IT IS I," alludes to God's revelation of his name to Moses, "I AM." To be in the presence of God is all we need to face the turbulent storms of life.

Like Elijah and the disciples let us focus on God, let us focus on Jesus and not the storm. Let us strive to always walk with Jesus for He alone has conquered for us all the storms in life. Let us listen to the tiny whispering voice of the Holy Spirit so that God's wisdom will nourish, guide and strengthen us and not the lies of the enemy which paralyzes us.

May The Mother God and St. Joseph, terror of demons, intercede for us all.

Welcome to Our Lady's Corner— Your Source for Catholic Inspiration



You are sitting down and suddenly become aware of a presence. Jesus is kneeling before you, ravaged, bloody, scourged and with a large thorny crown. One of his eyes is swollen shut, and the other is fixed upon you. You are caught up in his gaze; so much love you are dumbfounded. Your eyes move over his entire wounded body. You want to cry. Then you become aware that your body looks the same. You see wounds all over yourself. You are bleeding, too. He has not stopped his intense gaze. You look back into his gentle open eye.

"Jesus", you whisper, "Look at all of my wounds..." "Our wounds," He says softly and gently.

You are now given to know that many of your wounds are sins that others have committed against you. How they hurt! They are also wounds that you inflicted upon yourself with your own sins. Ouch!

Your eyes penetrate each other as you become one. He considers your wounds to be His wounds also. They hurt Him far worse than they hurt you. Your wounds are actually yours AND His wounds. They are not yours alone. They never were. You know this now.

Now you look around and see many other souls, also wounded and bloody. In pain. Jesus is kneeling before them as well, saying the exact same thing with just as much love and compassion. They have been wounded by you, others, and themselves also. You are as helpless as they are. Jesus is taking on their wounds and your wounds. This is not too much for Him! This is the way we should see each other from now on --others are in pain, too.

How strong and wonderful He is! How He longs for this very thing! How He longs for the chance to love and walk with them! He enters into everyone's suffering very willingly, and very profoundly. You only have to close your eyes and SEE with your heart. He is waiting for you. Your pain is His pain. Spend a few minutes alone today with eyes closed. See Him kneeling before you, bloody and beaten and desiring you, thirsting for you, waiting for you to invite Him into your pain. You are beaten, too. He only wants the chance to love you. You are simply beloved. Simply precious. Simply helpless without Him. And you can't carry whatever you are carrying alone. It is too much pain for you all by yourself. You are too little for this. Trust Him.

Apparition of Immaculate Mary

There are numerous apparition claims concerning the Blessed Virgin. However, there are only 16 apparitions validated by the Vatican.

The approved apparition for August is:

Our Lady of Knock August 21 (1879, Ireland)

Vignette: A silent apparition: Mary, St. Joseph, St John the Evangelist, and the Lamb on the altar--a vision of heavenly worship.

Inquiry: Commission of inquiry 1879; reaffirmed by later commissions; papal recognition by Pius XII (1936) and John Paul II (1979 visit).

Symbol: Lamb on altar

Prayer: *Queen of Ireland, draw us into the worship of the Lamb.*

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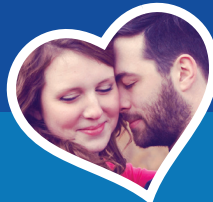
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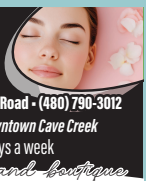
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
