

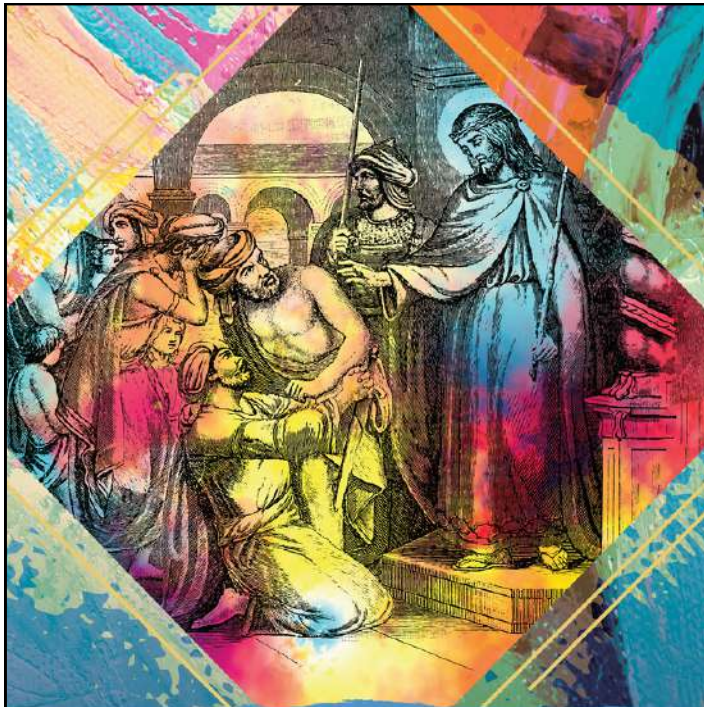

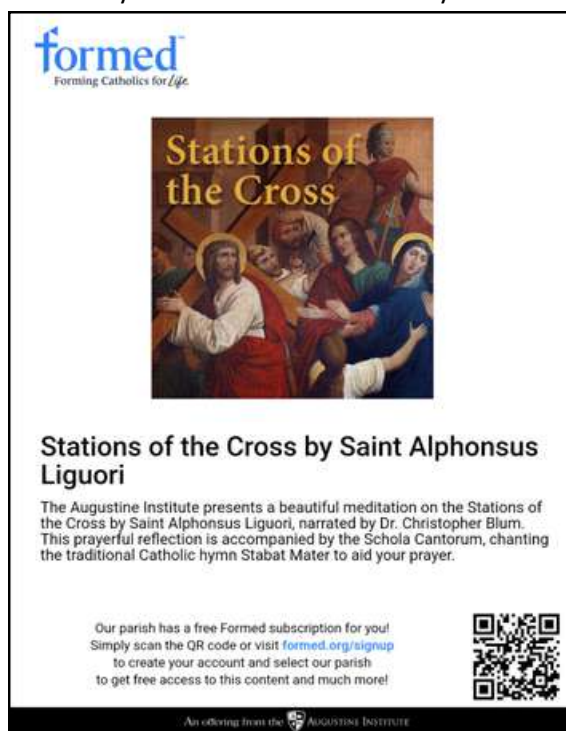

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross -- September 14

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, also known as the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross, commemorates three historical events: 1. The discovery of the True Cross in 326; 2. Its initial exaltation for public veneration in 335; and 3. The recovery of the Cross from the Persians in 628. The miraculous discovery of the Cross on September 14, 326, by Saint Helena, mother of Constantine, while she was on a pilgrimage to Jerusalem, is the origin of the tradition of celebrating this feast on this date. Reciting the Stations of the Cross is a wonderful way to celebrate this Feast Day!

A MESSAGE FROM FR. JESS

Dear Family of God,

Why the necessity to forgive our brothers or sisters?

St. James offers this warning: "For judgment is without mercy to the one who has shown no mercy" (Jas 2:13). This means that Divine and human forgiveness go hand in hand. Everyone must be tireless in forgiving each other, both the petty and the serious; the charity of Christ demands it (CCC #2227).

From the Book of Sirach, it says, "Forgive your neighbor's injustice; then when you pray, your own sins will be forgiven" (Sir. 28:2). When we forgive from the heart, God heals us from past hurts and we are at peace with God, with others and with ourselves. On the other hand, unforgiveness is self-destructive; it hinders our growth and robs us of peace.

We have been forgiven a debt which is beyond all paying – the debt of the sin of all mankind which brought about the death of God's own Son – and, if that is so, we must forgive others as God has forgiven us. Having experienced forgiveness at the hands of God and God's people, we are then called and given grace to forgive those who wound us in turn and so make it possible for others to experience God's Mercy through us. The gates of forgiveness are always open to anyone who turns away from sin (CCC #982).

May our Lady of Joy help us all to strive to be merciful as God is merciful to each one of us.

There have been so many attempts at peace in our world. They usually fall short. Why is that? The answer is really quite simple. Because we are human, and we always fall short. That is, we always fall short when we do not involve God, no matter what we do.

God sent His top messenger to Fatima with a peace plan over 100 years ago. Do you know that? Who is His top messenger, you ask? Why Mary, of course. What is Her peace plan? She told us at Fatima. Do you remember what She said?

She said God wanted Russia to be consecrated to her Immaculate Heart or Russia would spread her errors worldwide. So what happened? It wasn't. Not until 1984 when Pope John Paul II consecrated the world to Her Immaculate Heart, and then in 2022, when Pope Francis consecrated both Russia and the Ukraine to Her Immaculate Heart. Too late? 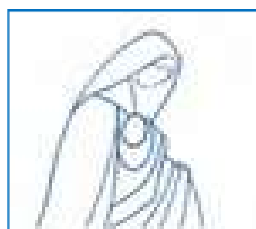
