

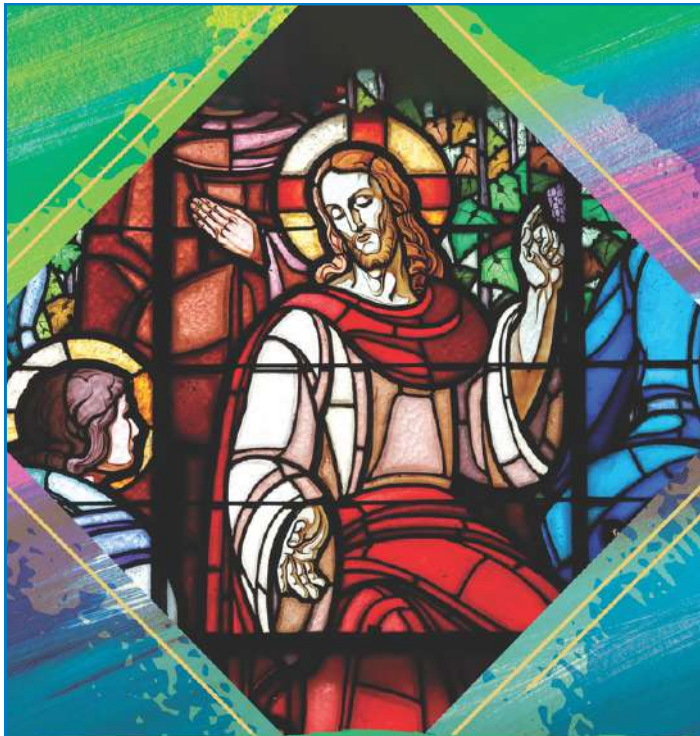

WHAT'S ON FORMED NOW?

St. Padre Pio of Pietrelcina - Feast Day September 23
(also the anniversary of his death in 1968)

St. Padre Pio is one of the most beloved saints of the 20th century! A Capuchin friar who bore the wounds of Christ for 50 years, converted thousands through the confessional, and whose intercession continues to work miracles around the world today. Born Francesco Forgione on May 25, 1887, in Pietrelcina, Italy, he consecrated himself to Jesus at the early age of five. On September 20, 1918, while kneeling before a large crucifix in the choir of the friary church at San Giovanni Rotondo, Padre Pio received the visible stigmata (the five wounds of Christ's Passion). He was just 31 years old. The wounds appeared on his hands, feet, and side, and they bled continuously for the next fifty years, until the day before his death. He was the first priest in the history of the Church to receive the stigmata.

A MESSAGE FROM ***FR. JESS***

Dear Family of God,

What is grace? How did he merit grace for us?

He is so patient with us and wants us all to be in Heaven with him. He patiently calls and waits for each one of us to answer his call to repentance and holiness, to intimate relationship with Him. Sometimes we feel that God is not fair in his dealings with each one of us. We compare ourselves with others just like the early workers in the vineyard who complained God's seemingly unfair wages to all the workers.

God does not deal with us "fairly" and it is a good thing! We should be thankful God does not give us what we deserve. The parable this Sunday tells us that our Heavenly reward is not something we earn, but rather a free gift. God has made His rewards available to all through Faith in Christ Jesus. Indeed, as Isaiah says from our first reading: "As high as the heavens are above the earth, so high are my ways above your ways and my thoughts above your thoughts" (Is. 55:9). It is in the context of forgiveness and mercy that God is far from us, not about having some understanding about him.

Heaven is not a personal reward it is a gift to us by God; our good works help us to be assured of that reward and help others to desire it. Our life itself is a gift from God and that is why many Saints will tell us it is all about grace. We make ourselves ready to receive it and help other do the same, for God is always willing to give to all but we too should be willing to receive them. Grace is an "undeserved love" that God has shown us through the death and Resurrection of His only Son Jesus Christ. "For it is all for your sake, so that grace extends to more and more people it may increase thanksgiving to the glory of God" (2Cor. 4:15).

May the Blessed Mother help us all to show our gratefulness for this great gift of Jesus in the Eucharist, by adoring him and allowing him to love us.

Five First Saturdays Devotion (continued from last week)

To fulfill the Five First Saturdays devotion (for five consecutive months):

1. Go to confession.
2. Receive Holy Communion while in a state of grace.
3. Pray five decades of the Rosary.
4. Spend 15 minutes keeping Our Lady company while meditating on one or more of the Rosary mysteries. (in quiet-alone)
5. Offer these acts with the intention of making reparation for the blasphemies against Her Immaculate Heart.

The observance of the First Saturday in honor of the Immaculate Heart of Mary is intended to console Her Immaculate Heart and make reparation for the blasphemies and ingratitude of humanity. This devotion and its associated promises were revealed by the Blessed Virgin Mary, as recorded by Lucia, one of the three children to whom Our Lady appeared in Fatima, Portugal, in 1917.

Mary promised to those who complete First Saturday Devotion to 1) assist at the hour of death 2) to supply graces necessary for salvation. She will supply you with the grace of perseverance. This takes the daily rosary to a whole new level. And since Mary said to do this, why wouldn't we? Remember the Wedding at Cana? This is the first recorded time Mary interceded, but far from her last. Her appearance at Fatima is no exception. It is another intercession for us! Fatima is a compelling story and Mary is very powerful. And how will Mary's peace plan play out? Not like a hollywood blockbuster with extreme special effects, no, heaven works much differently. First Saturdays will enact conversion graces - changing of hearts. Everyone is included, everyone is covered. People you would never expect to change can. God wants everyone - no exceptions. We must trust in this quiet, tranquil peace plan as the best plan - the best way. Just because you can't see it working doesn't mean it won't. You won't see the full effects until Jesus is before us all at the final judgement and all will be revealed. Wow - will we be amazed! Start your first Saturday devotion on Oct. 3. No excuses. Let's get real and do this.
